Laurent Killias clerked at a District Court in the Canton of Zurich; he was admitted to the bar in Switzerland in 1990.

Laurent Killias has published various works in the field of international litigation and arbitration, as well as in private international law and debt collection. In addition, he has delivered numerous lectures on the subject of international litigation and arbitration. Laurent Killias is also a co-founder of the Swiss Arbitration Academy. He is also a lecturer on international arbitration at the University of Zurich's LLM program in international business law.
